Dear Parents, Guardians, and Teachers:

Next week Monday through Wednesday (May 17-19) students who would like to buy extra milk (besides the carton that comes with the hot lunch tray) will need to bring change so that they can pay thirty cents per extra carton. Milk bills going home today in family folders cover extra milk bought through today.

General reminder: Fourth quarter report cards and records are not released to parents or forwarded to the next school until lunch bills, milk bills, book fees, library book fines, non-Catholic tuition, fines for damage to school books, etc., are paid in full. Reminders regarding money owed go home in family folders.

The last day of school is Wednesday, May 19, with regular dismissal. The End-of-Year Prayer Service and Awards Assembly will begin at 1:15 P.M. in the church. All are welcome.

Congratulations to our Eighth Graders! Graduation is tonight. The band will play from 6:15-6:30, and Mass begins at 6:30 P.M. Thanks to the children who volunteered to be servers, organists, greeters, choir and band members. Thanks to the parents who are providing their transportation.

It would be good if a few parents could volunteer to walk to the park with grades K-4 Monday afternoon. If the weather is bad Monday, the trip will be postponed until Tuesday afternoon. If the weather is also bad Tuesday, the trip will not be rescheduled.

Please turn in your registration packets before the end of the school year.

The supply lists for 2010-2011 should go home in the family folders Wednesday, the last day of school.

Report cards can be picked up in the home parish church entry foyers beginning Saturday, May 29. For our non-Catholic students, the reports will be in the Visitation Church entrance foyer. Remember that the churches are generally unlocked during daylight hours. If you happen to be out of town Memorial weekend, don't worry. The report cards will be left in the churches several weeks for your convenience.
