Mrs. Kemmerling will do 2-8 P.E., 5/6 homeroom, 5-8 Science, 6-8 Reading, 5/6 Religion, 4 English/Spelling, as well as 5/6 English/Spelling on Mondays and Thursdays. Mrs. Bassett is returning as Teacher-in Charge and will have 7/8 homeroom, 5-8 Social Studies/Geography, 8 Algebra, 7 Math, 7/8 English, and 7/8 Religion. Mrs. Gildehaus will have grade 4 homeroom, 4-6 Math, 4 Religion, 4/5 Reading, 4 Science, and 4 Social Studies/Geography—Missouri History. Ms. Prewett will have second and third grade. Mrs. Engelmeyer will have kindergarten and first grade. Our first day of school is August 18. The date of the open house will be shortly after school starts.
